



BOARD POLICY #621 STUDENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a Christian community, we want student behaviour and conduct to be guided by Jesus' command to love God above all and our neighbour as our self. This includes:

1. Our Relationship with God (Love)

- Speak of God in respectful ways.
- Encourage a close relationship with God in others as well as ourselves through activities such as Bible reading, prayer and worship.

2. Our Relationship with Those in Authority (Honour)

- Be respectful in our speech and conduct.
- Be obedient to those in authority over us.
- Encourage others to be respectful of authority.

3. Our Relationship with Others (Respect)

- Be respectful of others.
- Address each other properly and do not resort to name-calling, swearing or dirty language towards each other.
- Give of ourselves to others and encourage everyone to feel included.
- Remember that there is "no touching except for helping".
- Learn to apologize when we fail and to seek God's forgiveness as we strive to live in fellowship with one another.
- Respect each other's property and use it only with permission.

4. Our Relationship with school property (Care)

- Be careful in our use of school property which includes the books, furniture, equipment and the buildings.
- Treat the playgrounds and trees respectfully.
- Report any damage done and pay for damages when we are responsible.
- Accept personal responsibility for the cleanliness of the school and the grounds.
